Reminders:

Central Utah has moved to STAGE 1 FIRE RESTRICTIONS. While Stage 1 Fire Restrictions are in effect, the following acts are prohibited:

1. No campfires or open fires outside of agency-improved and maintained campgrounds and homesites in central Utah. Running water is required at cabins or homesites on unincorporated private land. Devices fueled by liquid petroleum are allowed.
2. No discharging of fireworks or other pyrotechnic devices outside of incorporated city limits or on public lands (city-specific restrictions may apply). Fireworks are always prohibited on all federal lands.
3. No shooting of exploding targets or tracer ammunition.
4. No cutting, grinding, or welding of metal in areas of dry vegetation. This includes acetylene torches.
5. No use of equipment without a working and properly maintained spark arrestor (if required).
6. No smoking near vegetation or outside of a developed recreation site, personal vehicle, or building.

FYI – Central Utah may be moved to Stage 2 by the end of July. Will post updates on the City's social media.

Dog Ordinance. Fountain Green City has an **Animal Control Ordinance. 13-20-3-02. License And Registration Required.** All dogs need to be licensed each year. **Dog Licenses were due by June 1, 2024. There will now be a \$30.00 late charge assessed. 13-20-3-04. Running At Large Prohibited.** It shall be unlawful for the owner/keeper of any dog to permit such dog to run at large (All dogs should be on a leash unless otherwise contained on the owner's property). **13-20-3-08. Dogs Required to Have Rabies Shots.** All dogs within the city shall have proof of up-to-date rabies shots. If you have dog complaints, please contact Fountain Green City Animal Control Officer– **Amy at 435-469-0018.**

Fountain Green City Land Use Ordinances. A permit is required for all buildings over 200 sq. ft. – houses, shed, lean-to, fences taller than 6' or solid (not see-through), etc. Any structures less than 200 sq. ft. and without utilities will not need to be submitted but still need to meet the required setbacks. An appointment must be scheduled to verify those setbacks. Applications for all permits are available at the City Hall and all required paperwork must be turned in at the City Hall at least one week before the meeting of the Planning Commission (second Thursday of each month). ****The public is not required to attend the meeting but must have submitted a complete application. If the ladies at the City Hall cannot answer your question(s) they will refer you to the secretary or chair of the Planning Commission.**
